- ❖ Enjoy fellowship & have fun through club social events and interest groups



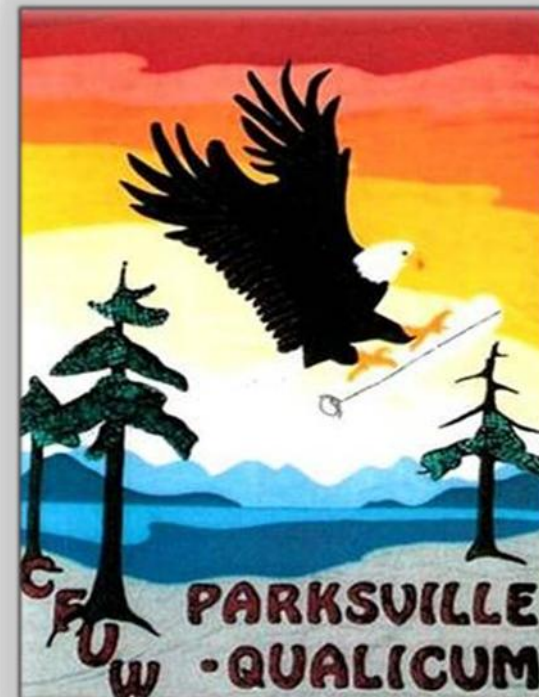
Scholarship and Bursary Trust
