APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED FROM: APRIL 1ST UNTIL May 31st DEADLINE

SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE PAID BY MID-AUGUST INTO THE STUDENT'S ACCOUNT AT THEIR INSTITUTION, TO BE USED FOR TUTION, BOOKS, ETC.

THE FUNDS MUST BE USED IN THE FORTHCOMING ACADEMIC YEAR. NO DEFERRALS ACCEPTED.

CFUW Parksville Qualicum Memorial Scholarship of \$4,000 given to women who graduated from a District 69 secondary school. Candidates must be registered as a student entering 2nd year of study or beyond in an accredited Canadian university/college undergraduate academic programme.

Postgraduate Scholarship one award of \$4,000 given to a woman who graduated from a District 69 secondary school. Candidates must be entering or continuing a postgraduate programme at an accredited university.

James Craig Reid Memorial Scholarship one award of \$4,000 given to any student (woman or man) who graduated from a District 69 secondary school. Candidates should be entering their 4th year of study or beyond in an accredited Canadian university academic programme. Preference will be given to candidates specializing in Music, Fine Arts, Liberal Arts or Education.

To be considered for the awards below you must have lived in SD69* for at least 3 years OR attended a SD69 secondary school.

Mature Student Bursary of \$3000 given to women from District 69 resuming their education immediately following an absence of at least two consecutive years. Candidates must be registered at an accredited Canadian educational institution.

Early Childhood Education Award one award of \$2,000 given to a woman who is entering her second year of a two-year Early Childhood Education programme at an accredited ECE training institution.

***School District 69** includes Bowser, Coombs, Dashwood, Errington, Lasqueti, Nanoose, Parksville, Qualicum Beach and Whiskey Creek

APPLICATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Each applicant must supply:

- A completed application form including the financial plan (pages 3 & 4 below).
- A personal letter outlining reasons for making the application, academic and work experience, volunteer and/or community experience, education and career goals.
- Appropriate transcripts
- A copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited educational institution, if it is different from the past year's one.
