1. THE SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships of \$2,000.00 each: one to be awarded to a women graduate of any of the four SD69 Secondary Schools, Kwalikum Secondary School, Ballenas Secondary School, Parksville Alternate Secondary School (PASS) and School District 69 Collaborative Education Alternative Programme (CEAP). These awards will be based on academic achievement, motivation, and involvement in extracurricular activities in the school and the community.

2. INSTRUCTIONS

The applicant must be proceeding by January of the following year at the latest, to a degree program at an accredited Canadian university or college or to a university transfer program at a Canadian college or educational institution. Failure to comply with this stipulation, will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

3. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- The completed application form
- A letter to the secondary school counsellor or administrator detailing your academic achievements so far, as well as community and school activities, outside interests (sports, church etc.) work experience and career goals.
- An updated copy of current grades 11 and 12 marks
- Two letters of reference from a teacher, employer, or community leader. The letters must be dated within the last two years.
- A copy of the chosen university's acceptance letter

4. RECIPIENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Award winners must inform The Scholarship and Bursary Trust of the name and address of their chosen university and their student number so that the funds may be sent to the Registrar/Bursar. If the winner does not pursue the program listed in the acceptance letter, the Trust must be notified. The Trustees will not accept a request for a deferral of the award.
